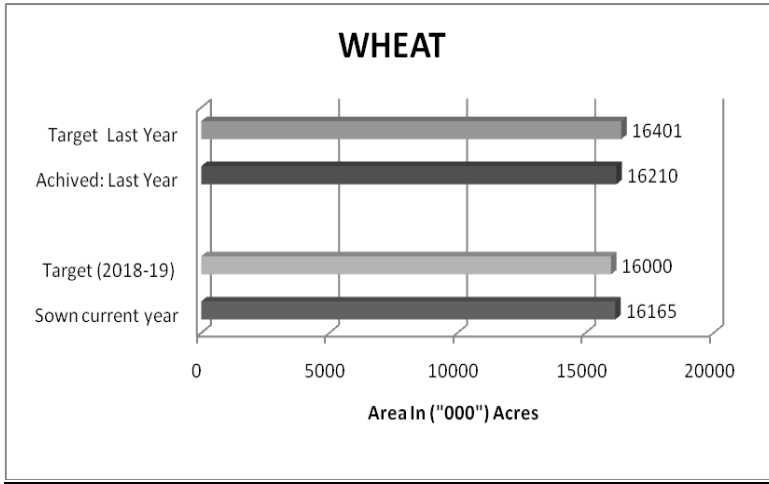

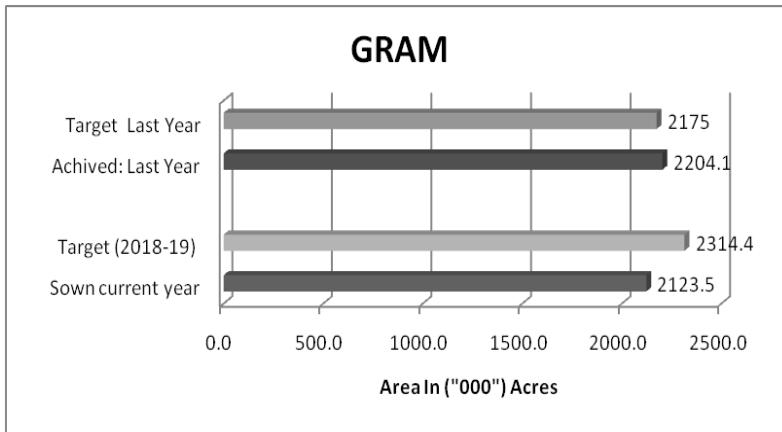

CROP SITUATION REPORT OF THE PUNJAB FOR THE FORTNIGHT ENDING 15th FEBRUARY, 2019.



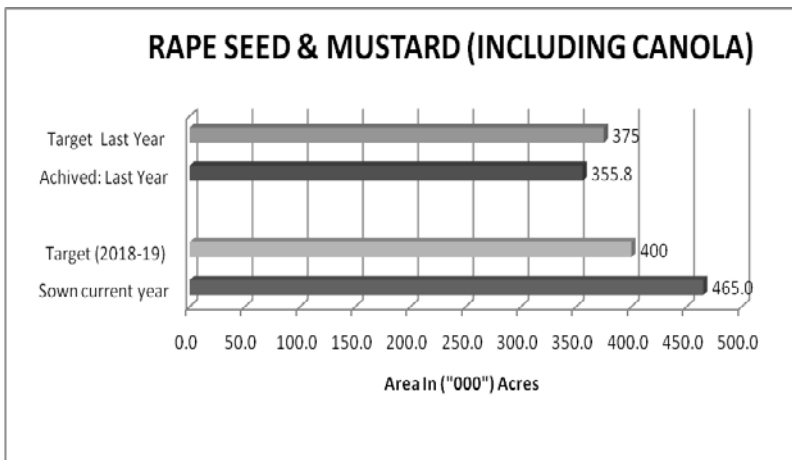
Sowing/condition

The growth and standing conditions of crop is reported/observed satisfactory. Early sown crop is attaining the earring stage, while mid and late sown crop is on growing stage. The rain received during the fortnight is reported beneficial for growth of wheat crop. The farmers remained busy in application of fertilizers to crop. The spraying of weedcidies also remained in progress during the fortnight. The present looking of crop is reported healthy.



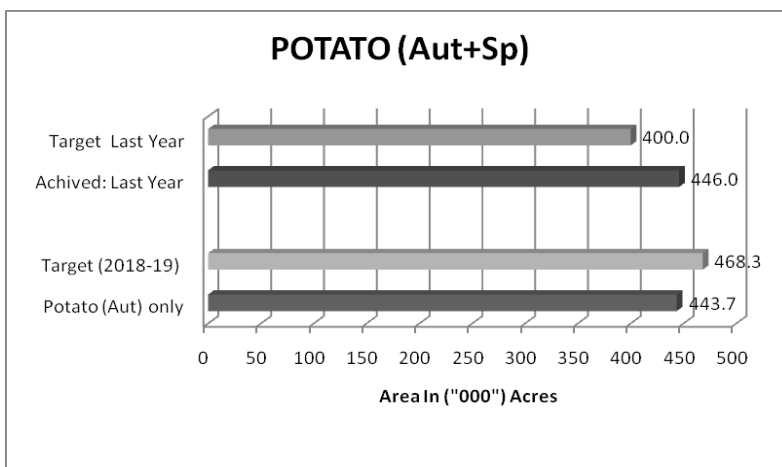
Sowing/Condition

The standing condition of the crop is reported normal. Early sown crop is on flowering stage while mid and late sown crop is on growing stage. The rain received during the fortnight is reported beneficial for growth of crop. The normal temperature during the coming month will support its productivity.



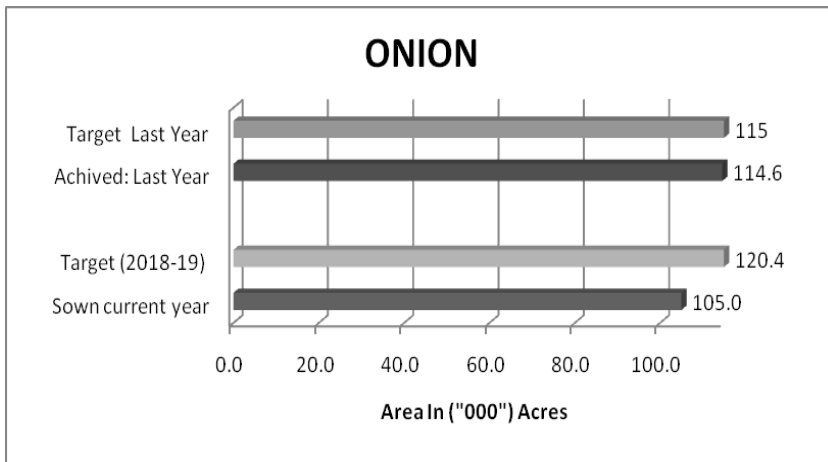
Sowing/Condition

The standing condition of different oilseed crops has been reported/observed satisfactory. Most of crop is at flowering, grain formation stage while early sown is approaching towards maturity stage.

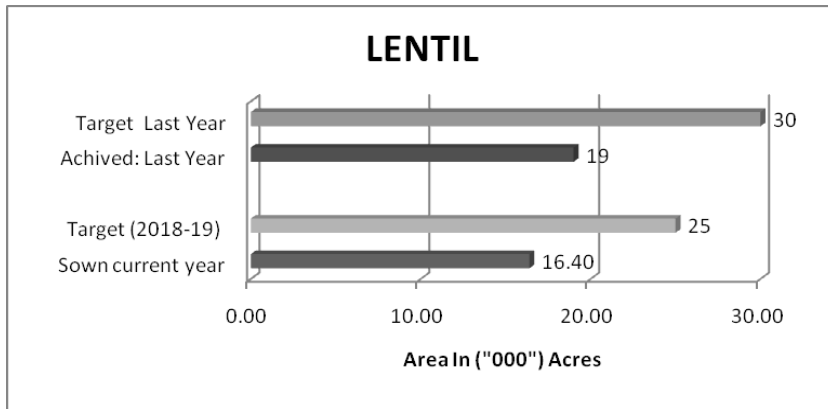

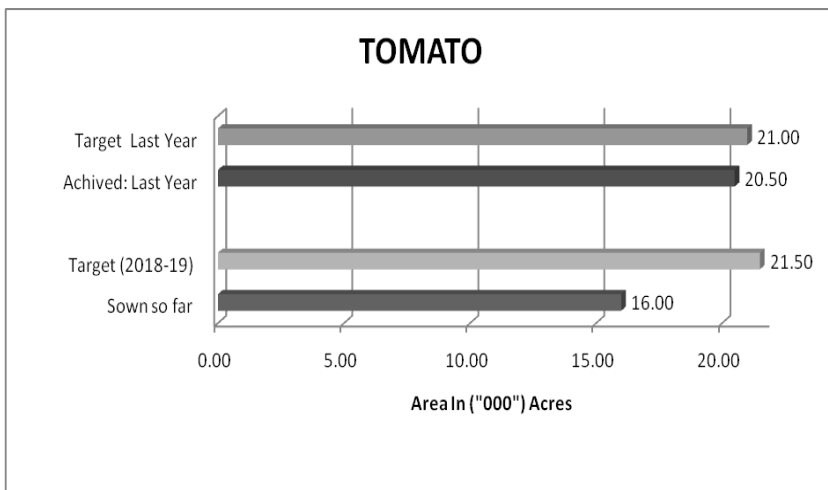

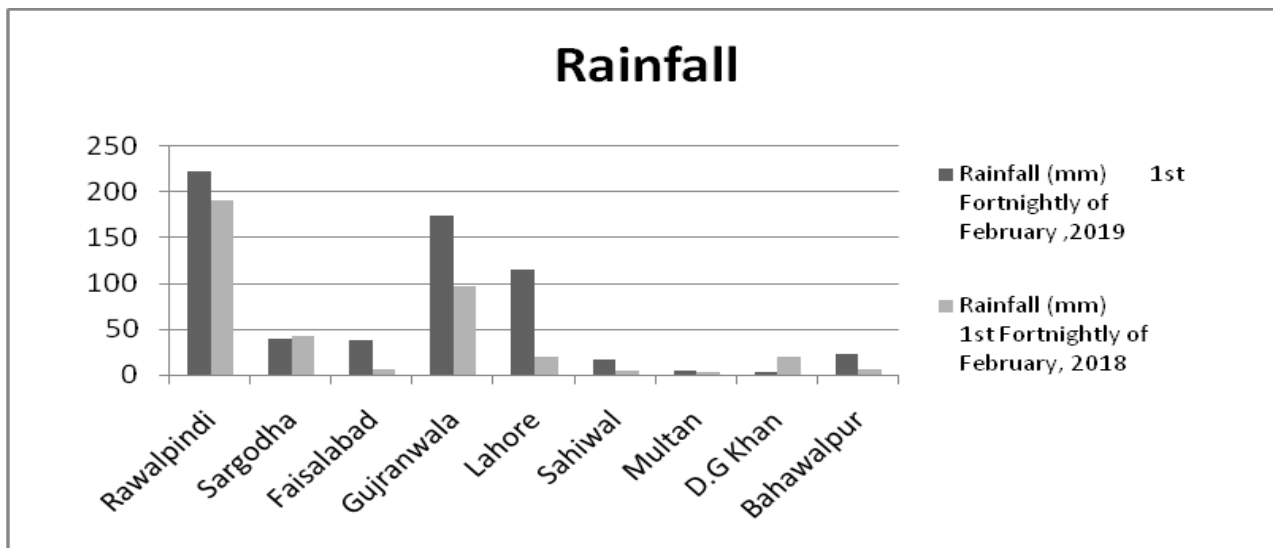
Sowing/Condition	The growth and condition of crop is reported satisfactory. The crop is at flowering stage.

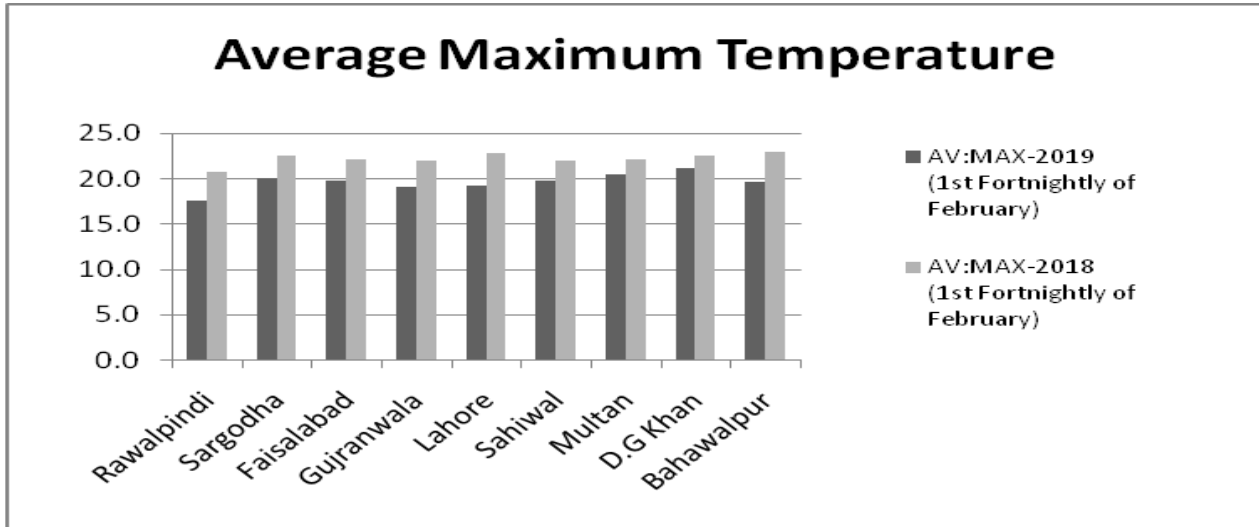

RAINFALL (DIVISIONAL)

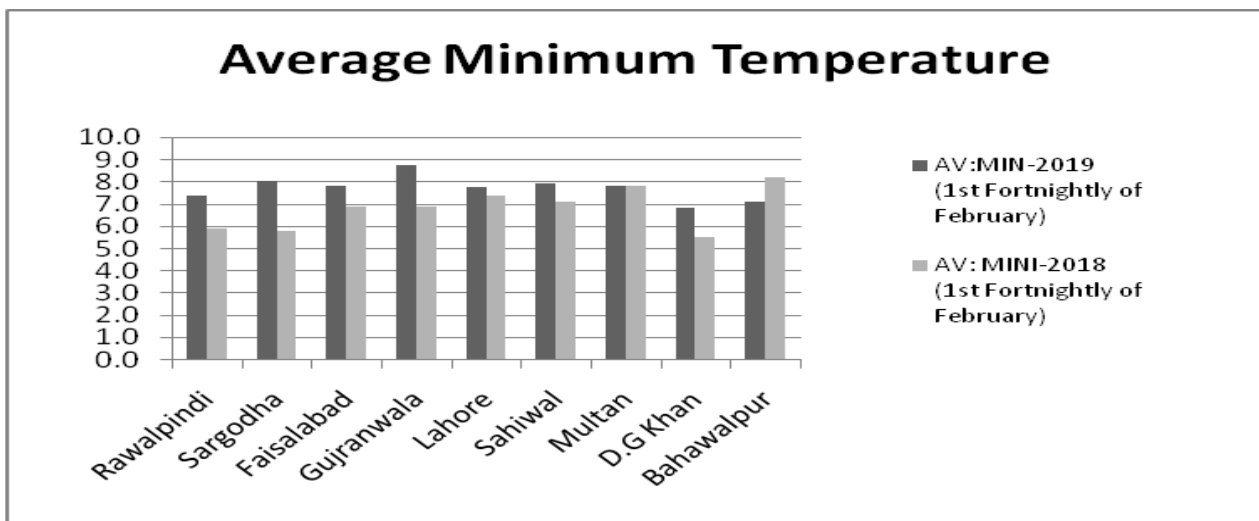

AVERAGE TEMPERATURE (DIVISIONAL)

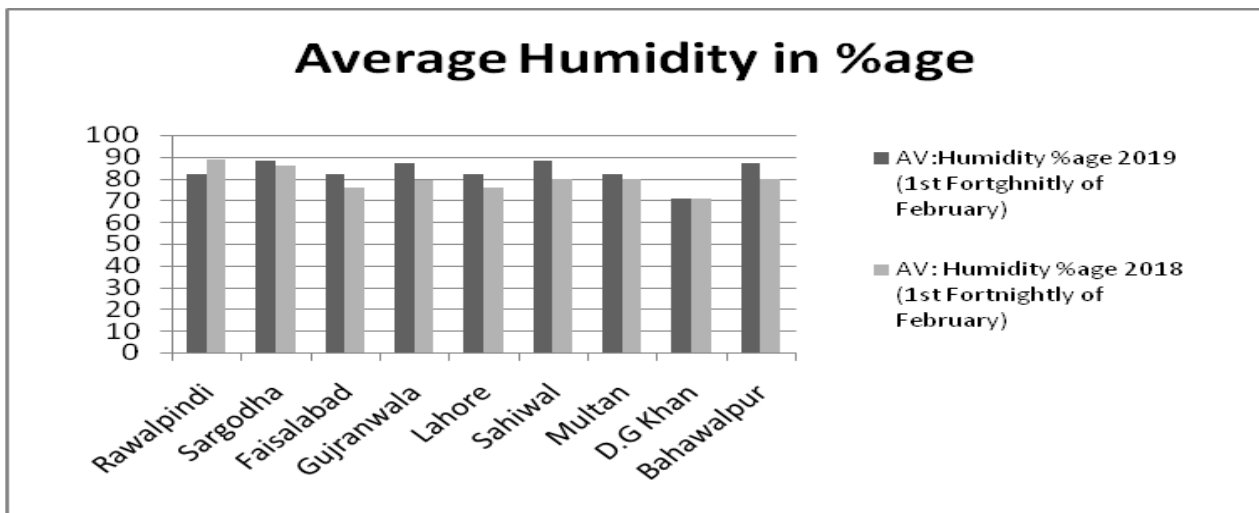
